Attorney Woo supplied Guidelines, the Form 700, and the Settlement agreement requested. He also supplied § 12902 of the Insurance Code and § 11552 of the Government Code in response to the request for “a document that reflects the total annual compensation of [the Insurance Commissioner].” Auditor indicated to Mr. Woo that the statutes were not the response she had requested. Mr. Woo replied, “We don’t have W-2s here” and “This is what you want.”

These statute citations are considered inadequate, in that they do not reveal the actual, annual compensation, but rather indicate the 1988 salary and the statutory method by which the maximum annual salary increase could be determined, and even then, **only if** additional information on annual increases given to state employees over the past 18 years was provided.

The request was **not how** the Insurance Commissioner’s maximum annual salary could be determined, but rather for the “**TOTAL ANNUAL COMPENSATION**” provided this state agency’s top-ranking employee (i.e., Insurance Commissioner).
